Complete the form NO LATER THAN **Monday 17**th **March,** completed by a caregiver and select all the sports you wish to be involved in. If you are UNABLE to complete the form online, you must see the Sports Coordinator ASAP to collect a paper form

APPLIES TO ALL CODES AND TEAMS

Official Rule in the NBHS rule book, sanctioned by the NBHS Board of Trustees

In order to represent NBHS in any co-curricular activity at ANY level, the following criteria must be met:

Senior Students (y11 to y13) 80% attendance (unless with a valid medical certificate)

Senior Students (y11 to y13) 100% NCEA internal assessment work completed

Junior Students (y9 to 10) 80% attendance

Junior Students (y9 to 10) Level of pastoral discipline not to exceed Deans 4.

PLAYER'S CODE

- Always play by the rules.
- Always respect referees and officials, they are volunteers, they sacrifice their spare time for you
- Control your temper for the good of the team

BASKETBALL

All players must pay General Basketball When Junior A and Senior A are selected there is a premier fee of \$100.00 per annum \$180.00 per annum

CANOE POLO

Please do not pay the below levy until your son is signed up and put into a team, Mr McDermott will then communicate costs to parents.

Bum Freezer Competition \$30 per annum

Winter League \$130-\$160 per annum

HOCKEY

- 1. The Hockey competition runs during Term 2 and 3
 - a. Division 1 & 2: 7th May 14th August, Games played on Wednesdays
 - b. Division 3 & 4: 5th May 18st August, Games played on Mondays
- 2. Games are played at either: Unison Hockey Stadium (Hastings) or HBH Stadium (Napier)
- 3. Uniform: some are provided, however some Junior Teams will wear their PE uniform
- 4. Students must provide their own hockey stick, mouth guard, shin pads and turf shoes
- 5. If a student chooses to play Hockey they are making a commitment to play each match as they will be part of a team. If they intend to play Hockey <u>and</u> another winter sport(s) then they must be sure that practices and games do not clash in which case one of the sports will need to be given up. This must be decided before the season starts.

As well as completing the registration form online for NBHS Sports, **All Hockey Players need to register themselves online via PlayHQ – once the teams are sorted you will be sent a link to register (this is new for 2025)**

CANOE POLO

- 1. The Winter Interschool Canoe Polo competition runs from: mid-June late September 2025
- 2. Games are played in Clive or Flaxmere. They are usually on a Sunday between 12pm 8pm or Monday to Thursday between 8pm and 10pm. Your son will probably play in a 2-hour slot during one of these times.
- 3. Bum freezer is a competition on our school pool, run in term 2 before winter Canoe Polo season starts. Any boys who enters winter competition will be invited to play bum freezer as well, others interested see Mr. McDermott
- 4. Boys are put in teams based on their availability. E.g. Hostel boys usually don't play Sundays!
- 5. Please indicate your son wants to play by completing the form. Full registration and payment will be taken later.
- 6. Please don't pay any money now but understand there will be a charges which will be due by the 31st May 2025
 - a. There is a winter season cost which will be between \$130 -\$160
 - b. The cost for Bum Freezer is \$30
 - c. Most of the Winter Polo fee goes on paying pool hire. Canoe Polo Hawke's Bay usually sets this fee in April. We'll advise ASAP.

FOOTBALL

- 1. Football competition runs during Term 2 and 3 on Saturday Mornings
 - a. Starting: 10th May 2025
 - b. Finishing: 23rd August 2025
- 2. Playing at the various secondary schools around Hawkes Bay, dependent on the draw.
- 3. Uniform: Shirts are provided, but students are required to buy school royal blue shorts and socks from the uniform shop. Some junior teams may need to wear their PE shirts
- 4. If a student chooses to play Football, they are making a commitment to play each match, as they will be part of a team. If they intend to play Football <u>and</u> another winter sport(s) then they must be sure that practices and games do not clash in which case one of the sports will need to be given up. This must be decided before the season starts.
- 5. Please note: all teams are provisional for the first 3 weeks of play.

RUGBY

- 1. The Rugby competition runs for 12 weeks, being played on Saturdays, playing at various Secondary Schools around Hawkes Bay.
 - Starting: 10th May 2025
 - Finishing on the 16th August 2025
- 2. Uniform: Students are required to purchase their jerseys and socks (From the uniform shop Open Thursdays at Lunchtime and Tuesdays after school. They can then use their PE shorts to play)
- 3. There is a team at NBHS for every young man who wants to play at whatever level they choose
 - No NBHS Student will be released to play for any club team, it is compulsory and supported by Hawkes Bay Rugby Union for all NBHS students to play for a Napier Boys' High School Team.
- 4. Students are expected to attend all trainings, meetings and **all games** as scheduled. We do not do default games! The draw is posted on the sports notice board each week as soon as it comes out
- 5. Teams will be determined on age and weight: (All ages are determined by age on 1st Jan 2025)
 - Division 1 (3rd XV)- U19 Open
 - Division 2 (C Grade/NBHS U15) U19 Open
 - Division 3 & 4 (D Grade) U14 Open, U15 Open, U16 & under 65kg, (No U17 players)
 - Division 5 & 6 (E Grade) U14 & under 75kg, U15 & under 63kg, (No U16 players)
 - Division 7 (F Grade) U14 & under 56kg, U15 & under 53kg
- 6. If a student chooses to play Rugby they are making a commitment to attend all trainings and play each match, they are making a commitment to their mates. If they intend to play Rugby <u>and</u> another winter sport(s) then we will work with another code to make this happen.
- 7. Volunteer Parent coaches are the life-force of Rugby at NBHS without you, rugby does not function. Please contact Director of Rugby George Konia (george.konia@hbrugby.co.nz) if you can support any team
- 8. ALL PLAYERS must also register for Rugby Xplorer (instructions here)
- 9. All Rugby players MUST weigh in for Rugby with HBRU here at school in A7 at LUNCHTIME dates here:
 - Monday 10th March- Year 9s
 - Tuesday 11th March- Year 10&11
 - Wednesday 12th March- Year 12&13

BADMINTON

- 1. The interschool Badminton competition runs on Tuesday afternoons straight after school until approximately 5.30pm in Term 2 and 3. The 2025 season will run for approximately 15 weeks starting on Tuesday 13th May
- 2. Games will be played at various venues, mainly in school gymnasiums on a home and away basis. Transport will be by school minibus, and on occasions by car, driven by a staff member, or parent of a player. Boys with full or provisional licences may with the permission of parents\caregiver transport themselves, without passengers, to away venues.
- 3. Students will play in their P.E. uniform with the exception of the "A" team(s) who will be provided with a top. Students <u>must</u> have their own racquet. This must be brought to practice along with PE gear.
- 4. If a student chooses to play Badminton they are making a commitment to play each match as they will be part of a team. If they intend to play Badminton <u>and</u> another winter sport(s) then they must be sure that practices and games do not clash in which case one of the sports will need to be given up. This must be decided before the season starts.

BASKETBALL

- 1. There is a Junior and Senior Basketball competition
- 2. Competition is played on **Monday/Friday** nights and will be played at the PGA, Centennial Hall, Hastings Stadium and various school gyms.
 - i. Monday Night (Premier): Starting 5th May, Finishing 18th August
 - ii. Friday Nights: Starting 9th May, Finishing 15th August
- 3. The boys are responsible for getting themselves to and from the venues.
- 4. It is critical that boys must attend registration/team setup meetings. This is where teams are formed and even though your son has registered online – he needs to listen to the notices to ensure he DOES NOT miss a meeting
- 5. Uniforms are provided, the cost of replacement if not returned at the completion of the season will be \$100 for the uniform. The uniforms are not to be worn outside of basketball games.
- 6. We are short of managers and coaches so if you can help out please contact the Sports Coordinator Kirsty McCallum (kmccallum@nbhs.school.nz).
- 7. Students are expected to attend all trainings, meetings and **all games** as scheduled by Basketball Hawkes Bay. We do not do default games!
- 8. All players are required to pay \$90 Basketball Levy, the <u>players selected for the Senior A, Junior A will be required to pay a \$180 Basketball Levy.</u>
- 9. If a student chooses to play Basketball, they are making a commitment to play each match, as they will be part of a team. If they intend to play Basketball <u>and</u> another winter sport(s) then they must be sure that practices and games do not clash in which case one of the sports will need to be given up. This must be decided before the season starts.

NETBALL

- 1. There is an open boy's competition
- 2. Competition is played on at the Hastings Sports Park on Wednesdays after school, starting 21st May
- 3. The boys are responsible for getting themselves to and from the venues.
- 4. It is critical that boys must attend registration/team setup meetings. This is where teams are formed and even though your son has registered online he needs to listen to the notices to ensure he DOES NOT miss a meeting
- 5. Students are expected to attend all trainings, meetings and **all games** as scheduled by Basketball Hawkes Bay. We do not do default games!
- 6. If a student chooses to play Netball, they are making a commitment to play each match, as they will be part of a team. If they intend to play Basketball <u>and</u> another winter sport(s) then they must be sure that practices and games do not clash in which case one of the sports will need to be given up. This must be decided before the season starts.
